Jesus is Called the Word of God.

- **Revelation 19:13:** “He is clothed in a robe dipped in blood, and the name by which he is called is The Word of God.”

Jesus is called, ‘The word of God,’ because He is God’s word manifest in the flesh, this does not mean He is God, but that:

- By his words he perfectly revealed God’s will to mankind.
- By his actions he perfectly revealed God’s character.
- By his miracles he perfectly revealed God’s power.
- By his compassion and kindness, he perfectly revealed God’s love.

The original manuscripts of the New Testament are written in Greek, and ‘word,’ in the Greek language, is ‘logos.’ Greek writers use personification in much of their language which is why logos is personified as a person, but in Greek language it never refers to a person, but always the written word. The phrase, “The word of God,” in Greek means the logos of God, and denotes the higher and divine nature of the Saviour. He is the Logos (word in English) of God in that He:

- Perfectly revealed God’s will and His eternal plans, purposes and revelations.
- Perfectly manifested God’s love, grace and character, and His miraculous power over creation (i.e., He walked on water, created fish and bread to feed thousands, calmed the storm, healed many, and raised the dead).
- Perfectly revealed God’s eternal plan for mankind’s Salvation, the eternal future of the faithful, and for the earth and all who dwell on it.

It is for these reasons He is given the title, “The word (logos) of God,” and why it is stated, “the word (logos) of God became flesh,” because He perfectly manifested God’s word in every way.
