A ROCK YIELDS WATER (WATERS OF MERIBAH).

The people assembled against Moses and Aaron and said, it would have been better for them if they had perished when their brothers perished before the LORD, why did Moses led them out of Egypt to this evil place in the wilderness to die? The people have no grain, figs, vines or pomegranates and there is no water to drink.

Then Moses and Aaron went from the presence of the assembly to seek the LORD and fell on their faces at the entrance of the Tent of Meeting. The Glory of the LORD appeared to Moses and Aaron and the LORD told Moses to take Aaron (Moses brother) and the Staff and assemble the congregation and stand before the assembly and tell the ROCK to yield water and the ROCK would yield water for the people and their cattle.

Moses strikes the ROCK at Meribah twice instead of speaking to it.

Moses took the Staff from before the LORD and gathered the assembly together before the ROCK, and says, "hear now you rebels we will now bring water for you out of this ROCK, then Moses lifted up his hand and struck the ROCK with his Staff twice and water came out abundantly so the congregation and their livestock drank. The waters where the people of Israel quarrelled were called the Waters of Meribah, because through the Waters of Meribah the LORD showed Himself Holy. The LORD told Moses and Aaron because they did not believe the LORD and uphold Him as holy in the eyes of Israel they will not bring Israel into the land.

The King of Edom does not let Israel pass through His Land.

The king of Edom was Israel's brother (Jacob and Esau are brothers and Esau is Edom) The king was aware of Israel's hardship in Egypt and that the LORD had sent an Angel to bring them out. While in Kadesh Moses sent messengers to the king of Edom to ask permission to travel through his land, he tells the king that Israel is now in a city called Kadesh on the edge of his territory and that they need to pass through his field, but will only travel along the King's Highway, they will not go into his vineyards or drink his water from a well.

The King of Edom refuses to let Israel passage through his Land.

The king of Edom said he would come out with the sword against Israel and refused to let Moses pass through, so the people of Israel told the king of Edom again that they would only travel on the king's highway and if they drank his water they would pay for it, but the king came out against Israel with a large army and a strong force and refused to give Israel passage through his territory, so Israel turned away from the king of Edom and journeyed from Kadesh and came to Mount Hor.

Aaron will die before they enter the Land.

The LORD told Moses and Aaron at Mount Hor on the border of the land of Edom that Aaron would not enter the Promised Land, because they rebelled against the LORD'S command at the Waters of Meribah, but he will be gathered to his people (those that have died).

Aaron's son Eleazar replaces Aaron.

The LORD told Moses to take Aaron and Eleazar and his sons and bring them up to Mount Hor and strip Aaron of his Priestly Garments and put them on Eleazar his son, because Aaron is about to die on Mount Hor and be gathered to his people

(those that have died). Moses Aaron and Eleazar and his sons went up Mount Hor in the sight of the entire congregation and Moses stripped Aaron of his Priestly Garments and put them on Eleazar his son.

The LORD takes Aaron to his Fathers on Mount Hor.

Aaron died on the top of Mount Hor, Moses and Eleazar went down from the mountain and for 30 days the entire congregation wept for Aaron because they saw that he had perished.
