Numbers 28.

The following is a brief overview of the main topics.

The LORD tells Moses that Israel was to make sure they offered the LORD'S food for His food offerings to Him at their appointed time.

They became food for the priests that is why they are called the LORD'S food offerings.

The Morning and Evening Offering.

The evening and morning sacrifice was ordained at Mount Sinai. It was called the regular burnt (*cooked*) offering and was offered to the LORD every evening and every morning of every day as the LORD'S food offering.

The Offering consisted off: -

- Two male Lambs a year old without blemish.
- A Grain offering of a 10th of an ephah of fine flour mixed with ¼ hin of beaten Oil with each Lamb.
- A Drink offering of ¼ hin of Wine.

Both the Evening and Morning offering was to be offered in the same way and both offerings where a pleasing aroma to the LORD (meaning they became food for the priests).

The Sabbath Day.

A Burnt (*cooked*) offering was to be offered every Sabbath Day, besides the regular Evening and Morning offerings.

The Offering consisted off: -

- Two male Lambs a year old without blemish.
- A Grain offering of two 10th of an ephah of fine flour mixed with Oil.
- And its Drink offering.

It was a pleasing aroma to the LORD (meaning it became food for the priests).

The Monthly Offering.

At the Beginnings of Each Month a Burnt (*cooked*) offering of: -

2 Bulls ---- 1 Ram ---- 7Lambs ---- 1 Goat ---- Was to be offered.

The two bulls were to be offered with: -

- A Grain offering of three 10th of an ephah of fine flour mixed with Oil.
- A Drink offering of a ½ hin of Wine.
- The Grain and Drink offering was to be offered with each Bull.

It was a burnt (*cooked*) food offering with a pleasing aroma to the LORD (meaning it became food for the priests).

The Ram was to be offered with: -

- A Grain offering of two 10th of an ephah of fine flour mixed with Oil.
- A Drink offering of a 3rd hin of Wine.
- To be offered with the Ram.

It was a burnt (*cooked*) food offering with a pleasing aroma to the LORD (meaning it became food for the priests).

The 7 male Lambs a year old without blemish were to be offered with: -

- A Grain offering of one 10th of an ephah of fine flour mixed with Oil.
- A Drink offering of ¼ hin of Wine.
- The Grain and Drink offering was to be offered with every Lamb.

It was a burnt (*cooked*) food offering with a pleasing aroma to the LORD (meaning it became food for the priests).

One male Goat for the sin offering to the LORD was also to be offered.

These were all to be offered to the LORD at the beginnings of each month throughout the months of the year and offered besides the regular Evening and Morning burnt (*cooked*) offering with their Drink and Grain offerings.

Note; all animal offerings had to be from Israel's own herd and the drink offerings were to be poured out to the LORD in the Holy Place.

Passover Day and the Feast of Unleavened Bread.

Deut. 16:6-8 -----⁶you shall offer the Passover sacrifice, in the evening at sunset, at the time you came out of Egypt. ⁷And you shall cook it and eat it at the place that the LORD your God will choose. And in the morning you shall turn and go to your tents. ⁸For six days you shall eat unleavened bread, and on the seventh day there shall be a solemn assembly to the LORD your God. You shall do no work on it.

On Passover Day.

Each house was to take its own lamb without blemish it was to be eaten at sunset on the 14th day of Abib. The next day (15th) was a Sabbath Day they were to hold a continual feast for 7 days with the last day (21st) also being a Sabbath. No leaven was to be eaten for all 7 days.

On the 15th day, the first day of the continual Feast of Unleavened Bread a Burnt (*cooked*) food offering was to be offered to the LORD.

This offering was: -

- 2 Bulls ---- 1 Ram ---- 7 Male lambs a year old without blemish.

The two Bulls were to be offered with: -

- A Grain offering of three 10th of an ephah of fine flour mixed with Oil for each Bull.

The Ram was to be offered with: -

- 1 Ram.

- A Grain offering of two 10th of an ephah of fine flour mixed with Oil for the Ram.

The seven lambs were to be offered with: -

- A Grain offering of one 10th of an ephah of fine flour mixed with Oil for each Lamb.

The Goat was to be offered with: -

- 1 male Goat for a Sin offering to make Atonement for Israel.

Note; all offerings were to be offered besides the Evening and Morning offering with its Grain and Drink offering. Passover Day (14th) and the 7th Day of Unleavened Bread (21st) were both to be a Holy Days (Sabbath) and no ordinary work was to be done.

Firstfruits Offering (this was also called the Feast of Weeks).

A Grain offering of new grain was offered to the LORD on the day the first fruits or sheath of the crop appeared, this offering was called the Feast of Weeks. Israel was to have a Holy Convocation (Sabbath) and not do any ordinary work, but a burnt (*cooked*) offering with a pleasing aroma to the LORD was to be offered, meaning it became food for the priests.

This Offering consisted of: -

2 Bulls ---- 1 Ram ---- Seven male Lambs a year old without blemish.

The Bulls were to be offered with: -

- A Grain offering of three 10th of an ephah for each Bull.

The Ram was to be offered with: -

- A Grain offering of two 10th of an ephah for each Ram.

The 7 male lambs a year old without blemish were to be offered with: -

- 7 male lambs a year old without blemish.
- A Grain offering of one 10th of an ephah for each Lamb.

The Goat.

- 1 male Goat was to be offered to make Atonement for Israel.

All Offerings.

The offering made for the Sabbath day, the Beginning of Months, the Passover, the Feast of Unleavened Bread and Firstfruits were all to be offered without blemish and were all to be offered in addition to the regular Morning and Evening offering.
